Mr. Philp has served as the head policy staff member and senior advisor in the personal office of Congressman Lamar Smith of Texas since 2013.

His legislative and communications work focuses extensively on intellectual property, patent reform, immigration law, regulatory reform, technology policy, and legal issues for Rep. Smith, who chairs the House Science, Space, and Technology Committee and who is the former chairman of the House Judiciary Committee.
